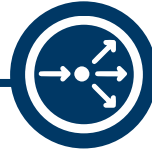


Targeted medicines:

Epidermal Growth Factor Receptor (EGFR) in lung cancer



- Around **10-15%** of lung cancers have *EGFR* mutations¹
- *EGFR* positive lung cancers respond to **targeted treatment**¹
- But with standard diagnostic processes it can take up to **60 days** for patients to be identified and start treatment²



We are supporting a pilot trial in Wales to test an innovative **liquid biopsy technique** that uses a simple blood test to detect mutation type at an earlier stage.



'QuicDNA' ctDNA biopsy can return results in **7-10 days**



Trial in **1,260** people with suspected stage III or IV lung cancer ongoing
